Choice greetings in the name of Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior. We are so excited about this year's Salvation Station International Kids Camp. Here's a list of what they can and what they cannot bring.

KEEP THIS AT HOME SO YOU'LL KNOW WHAT TO BRING.

Medications:

- Medications, aspirin, mouthwash are to be handed to one of our camp nurses
- Place the following in a "Zip Lock" bag
- Child's name on the medicine and on the instructions.
- Symptoms or side effects of medication we need to be aware of
- Detailed instructions: dosage, time to take, and whether with or without food.

What NOT to bring:

- **NO CELL PHONES**
 - Parents can call Acadian Baptist Camp (337) 457-9047 and leave a message and we will return the call at our earliest convenience.
- No TVs, radios, CD players, IPODS, IPADS, Laptops, Kindles, or any type of hand held Electronic Games
- No Toys, board games, deck of cards, books or magazines
- No camping knives

What to bring: PLEASE WRITE YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON EVERYTHING

- Pillow, sleeping bag or sheets and blankets
- 3 Towels, beach towels, face cloth, comb or brush
- Soap, hair shampoo, tooth brush and toothpaste
- Insect repellent with high "Deet" protection (mosquitoes) (put name on it)
- Sunscreen with high SPF protection (put name on bottle)
- MIN OF 5 OUTFITS: Shorts, T-Shirts, socks, underwear, sleepwear.

- **No halter tops or shirts that expose belly or SHORT shorts**
- **Swim suit (FOR GIRLS IT HAS TO BE A ONE PIECE OR NO SWIMMING)**
- **Tennis shoes and Pool Shoes (Beach Shoes or Swimming Shoes)**
- **“Floatees” if needed (There is a shallow end of the pool)**
- **Bible, notebook, pen**
- **Flashlight**
- **Money for concessions**
- **A backpack will make things a lot easier for the campers**

ON THE DAY OF REGISTRATION

***** Must wear swimsuit under clothes or carry it with you (not in suitcase). We will be swimming as soon as we get there. There'll be no time to wait to unpack*****

JUNIOR CAMP: Ages: 5 – 8 yrs old Friday June 29th from 8:30 – 10 AM at the Family Worship Center Foyer (front doors). Buses must leave on time: 10:30 AM.

SENIOR CAMP: Ages 9 – 12 years old Monday July 2nd from 10:00 – 11:30 AM at the Family Worship Center Foyer (front doors). Buses must leave on time: Noon.

If you miss the bus a map will be provided for you to drive your child to the camp. Bus HAS to leave on time.

ALL PARENTS OR LEGAL GUARDIAN MUST COME IN WITH THEIR CHILD EVEN IF THEY HAVE PRE-REGISTERED.

Please drop off your luggage under the canopy at designated areas. Please park your car in the parking lot...not under the canopy then parents and guardians need to come in with the camper to assist them through the different check in stations.

Every child, worker, and counselor will be checked for lice. We're sorry to say but all campers with lice and/or eggs will not be able to participate. Refunds will be made.
