

TO FOLLOW CHRIST involves suffering with Him and ensures the hatred of Satan, for the storm designed to hurt Christ would have also destroyed His disciples.

The phrase, "And, behold, there arose a great tempest in the sea," emphasizes the idea that since Christ was with them, they hardly expected a storm.

The terminology implies that the storm was very violent. It was designed by Satan but, at the same time, it was allowed by the heavenly Father as Satan can only do what the Lord allows him to do.

Understand, Satan is on a leash. This means that he can only do what the Lord allows him to do. He will claim to do all kinds of things, but if you have noticed, they never really came to pass. That's because, despite his bluster, he simply cannot do what he claims he's going to do.

Every believer belongs to the Lord. We are His children.

He has paid a great price for us, and to be sure, He loves us very much. This means that we should not fear Satan, what he claims he is going to do, or his threats. We belong to the Lord, and He is not going to allow anything to happen to us that is bad, unless there is a reason.

Would it have been possible for Satan to have killed Christ and the disciples? No. Because Christ was born without sin and lived without sin, He could not have been killed. When He was crucified, He made the statement, "I lay down my life, that I might take it again. No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of My Father" (John 10:17–18).

Could Satan have killed the disciples without killing Christ? Again, no. Satan could not have killed the disciples as long as Jesus was in the boat with them, and as long as they were walking in faith and believing. That being the case, neither they, nor any child of God, can be taken until the Lord desires that such be taken.

All who follow the Lord are the property of the Lord and, as such, do not answer to

Satan. In fact, every believer has a hedge built about him to protect him from the Evil One. Through unbelief or unconfessed sin in his life, the believer can allow that hedge to come down, but only if he allows such madness.

The Lord will, at times, allow some things to happen to believers that are very unsavory to teach us trust and to teach us faith in Him. In a sense, the storm upon the sea was one of those times.

The Evil One is not independent regarding anything. We learn from Job 1-2 that Satan can only do what the Lord allows him to do. Even then the Lord sets the boundaries. Satan no doubt appeared before the heavenly Father to ask permission to bring about this storm, and he probably asked for much greater latitude than what was given. Nevertheless, God drew the boundaries, allowing him certain latitude.

But why would God allow Satan to do anything?

Of course, Satan means us harm, and great harm at that. However, the Lord allows the Evil One certain latitude for our faith to be strengthened, for our dependence on the Lord to grow even greater, and for us to learn, even on an hourly basis, that we must, without fail, look to the Lord constantly. Adversity causes us to do that.

The phrase, "insomuch that the ship was covered with the waves," refers to the intensity of the storm and Satan trying to sink the ship while Christ was asleep.

The phrase, "but He was asleep," portrays two things:

1. As man, Christ became tired like all other men, and He was probably very tired at this time, especially after healing the sick and performing miracles. Christians who don't understand the incarnation cannot feature Christ having the same limitations as all other men. Even though He was God and never ceased to be God, Christ never once used His attributes of deity. Instead, He functioned as a man filled with the Holy Spirit. As someone has said, while Jesus laid aside the expression of His deity, He never for a moment laid aside the possession of His deity. As a man, He grew tired, needed rest, and had to find out about things exactly as all other men, unless the Holy Spirit revealed things to Him,

which He often did.

2. Inasmuch as everything Jesus did was designed by the Holy Spirit, His being asleep (at least at

this particular time), was designed by the Spirit of God. It would be used to teach the disciples their need of Him, His Power, and the manner in which He used it.

Most every child of God has gone through similar circumstances when the storm was raging, and it seemed like the boat was sinking, and it seemed as if God were asleep. But though He delay, it does not necessarily mean (and in similar cases will never mean) that He is not aware or that He denies.

LORD, SAVE US: WE PERISH

"And his disciples came to him, and awoke him, saying, Lord, save us: we perish" (Matt. 8:25).

The phrase, "And his disciples came to him, and awoke him," specifies that they were desperate. The disciples knew the Sea of Galilee very well. They had plied these waters all their lives and had faced many storms. But the intensity of this storm was such that they must have His help. Likewise, there is no way that one can get through this life without His help.

As well, you will find that a true call of God will arouse the enmity and

hatred of Satan as nothing else does.

The phrase, "saving, Lord, save us

The phrase, "saying, Lord, save us: we perish," means they had exhausted all their resources in keeping the ship afloat and now, despite their vast knowledge in these things, had no hope of escape except through Christ.

Psychology refers to Christianity as a crutch and implies that man is able to get by without such dependence. But those who uphold psychology completely misunderstand man's relationship with God because the root of psychology is unbelief in God.

While religion may be a crutch, and it most definitely is, Bible Christianity is not a religion but a relationship with a person—the Man, Christ Jesus.

Inasmuch as a child cannot or should not get by without his parents, man, in like manner, cannot get by without God.

The entire thrust of the fall of man in the garden of Eden is that he, in effect, in changing lords from God to Satan, has attempted to survive without Jehovah. That he cannot do, at least not properly so.

The biggest problem with man is to get him to admit that he needs the Lord. The idea of self-sustenance is strong in the rebellious heart. That's the reason songs such as "My Way" sound macho to most. The truth is, if man does it his way, which, in effect, is the devil's way, he will certainly be lost.


Actually, the entirety of the conflict is over God's way versus man's way.

To admit the need for help is not only not wrong, it is very right. But most of mankind and even the church seeks help from anything other than the right source. They seek it from other men. This is the thrust of psychology, which is no help at all.

The idea this scenario on the sea is as follows:

- *The journey*. There is a journey of life that all must take and, at times, for most, it is not pleasant.
- *The storm.* One could say that storms will come into every life, and many of them with the same intensity as the one recorded in Matthew 8:24-26.

Sadly, much of the modern teaching in Christian circles is that if one properly confesses the Word of God, all such storms can be eliminated.

It should be obvious that such is foolishness. This storm came even though Christ was in the boat. But some purveyors of this false doctrine of modern confession would suggest that if Christ had the faith they had, He could have eliminated the storm. Of course, false doctrine knows no limitations in its boundaries of impropriety.

Understand, the storms are going to come. Of that, you can be sure. But whatever the storm, as long as Christ is in the boat, that boat is going to make it to the other side. That is at least part of the lesson being taught in this scenario.

Even though Christ was in the boat, His help had to be properly solicited. No, the disciples saying "we perish" was not a bad confession, it was the truth. As Matthew 8:26 shows, the Lord did not admonish them for their statement; He admonished them for their lack of faith.

In truth, they would learn the lesson here taught as they would face many similar storms in later years and would weather them because of their faith in God and because of the lessons they had learned at the feet of their Lord and our Lord. Their faith was misplaced, as the next verse in this passage will show.

WHY ARE YOU FEARFUL?

"And he saith unto them, Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith? Then he arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm" (Matt. 8:26).

The phrase, "And he saith unto them," is meant to portray the reason for their dilemma. If one will properly discern what Christ is saying, the answer will be forthcoming.

The question, "Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith?" is a question that should be applied to all.

Why were the disciples fearful?

In this case, their faith was in His bodily presence. As such, it was misplaced, which this scenario is meant to portray, at least in part.

As long as Jesus was bodily present, they were, in effect, not using any faith at all and depending totally on Him. This episode would portray the wrong in such action.

THE PRICELESS CORNER

We have set aside this corner of *The Evangelist* to show God's plan of salvation. If you are unsure where you will go when you die, please listen to what God has said in His Word:

1. GOD LOVES YOU!

"For God so loved the world, that he gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life" (John 3:16).

2. MAN IS A SINNER, AND SIN HAS SEPARATED HIM FROM GOD

"For there is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not" (Eccl. 7:20).

"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God" (Rom. 3:23).

3. JESUS CHRIST IS THE ONLY REMEDY FOR SIN

"For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God ..." (I Peter 3:18).

"Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved" (Acts 4:12).

4. YOU MUST RECEIVE JESUS CHRIST AS YOUR PERSONAL LORD AND SAVIOR

Jesus calls this experience the new birth. He told Nicodemus: "Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God" (John 3:3).

We invite you now to receive the Lord Jesus Christ as your personal Savior. "But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His Name" (John 1:12).

DEAR JIMMY: TODAY I ACCEPTED JESUS AS MY LORD

He was telling them, in effect, that whether He was bodily present or not, He was still present, and they were to have faith in Him accordingly. The lesson would not be lost on them, for they would exhibit great faith after His ascension.

Little faith always produces fear, and fear has torment, as John would later say in I John 4:18. This same verse says, "*There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear,*" which was probably drawn from this episode of the storm.

Little faith, which produces fear, is the plight of humanity. Also, faith must not be misplaced, as it was here and often is. Our faith must be in Christ.

Strong faith is only brought about by properly knowing and understanding the Word of God, for "Faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God," which means to properly hear and understand the Bible (Rom. 10:17).

To bring it down to its most common denominator, the story of the Bible is Jesus Christ and Him crucified. That is the theme of the Word of God. If one understands the cross of Christ—and we are speaking of both salvation and sanctification—then one understands the Word of God.

Without understanding the cross in totality and, while some things can still be understood about the Word, there will be deficiency.

When you read the first two chapters of I Corinthians, you will find that the Holy Spirit, through the apostle Paul, puts the wisdom of this world—and we mean the best and the brightest the world can produce—into the also-ran column, so to speak.

The Holy Spirit places the ministry of the cross as the highest form of wisdom known to heaven or earth. In other words, what Jesus did at Calvary's cross presents itself as an exhibition of the highest wisdom of God. So when you learn and understand the cross of Christ, even as it regards salvation and sanctification, you have tapped into the wisdom of the ages.


A proper understanding of the Word of God, which can only be had by one properly understanding the cross, will alleviate all fear.

Jesus used the phrase, "O ye of little faith," four times in the

book of Matthew. Each of these four times, He addressed a particular problem:

- 1. The problem of care: "Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which today is, and tomorrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith?" (Matt. 6:30). In this passage, the Lord is telling us that if we will properly serve Him, look to Him, and have faith in Him, then He will take care of our financial needs.
- 2. The problem of fear: "And he saith unto them, Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith?" (Matt. 8:26). Once again, if we are doing our best to live for God as we should and have our faith properly placed in Christ and the cross, then there should be no fear present. We belong to Him! He has paid a great price for us. That being the case, and understanding that He is constantly watching over us, there is no reason to fear, none whatsoever.
- 3. The problem of doubt: "And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?" (Matt. 14:31). In this scenario, Jesus is dealing with Peter—and all of us as well. Do we doubt God's provision? Do we doubt His protection? The question, "wherefore didst thou doubt?" proclaims the ultimate cause of faith that weakens. We allow circumstances that seem to be extremely adverse, to produce the doubt that weakens our faith. The Greek word for doubt is distadzo, and it means "to waver mentally."
- 4. The problem of reasoning: "Which when Jesus perceived, he said unto them, O ye of little faith, why reason ye among yourselves, because ye have brought no bread?" (Matt. 16:8). Jesus had told His disciples to beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees. But they really didn't know what He was talking about. They certainly should have known, considering the opposition of the Pharisees and the Sadducees, exactly as believers presently ought to be able to discern false doctrine.

So, the four times that Jesus used the phrase, "O ye of little faith," He addressed care, fear, doubt, and reasoning. Again, Christ is going to reach the other side of life's journey, and if we hold to His nail-scarred hand, we will make it as well.

Recently I heard again a message that seems to fit just right for February, a time when love is reaffirmed. It's a message that our dear friend, Pastor J. Don George, preached here in 2019 titled, "Testing Your BMK." You'll have to keep reading to find out what those letters stand for, but what he had to say (pared down to fit these pages) will leave you smiling and feeling good about being a child of God. A little over a year after preaching this, the Lord called Brother George home, and we miss him more than words can say. But thank God, his messages are still with us, still anointed by the Holy Spirit, and still blessing the body of Christ in a way that only Brother George could.

A Test of Love

JESUS CHRIST, the Son of God, is fabulously in love with you. He loves you regardless of what you have done this past week. What you did this past week did not change His attitude toward you. Jesus loves you—always has, always will. He'll never stop loving you. He'll go on loving you eternally. I have come to bring you a message that I have titled, "Testing Your BMK," that's your Basic Minimum Knowledge concerning the Word of God. II Timothy 2:15 says, "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing [or handling accurately] the word of truth." So we'll take this test to get an understanding of your BMK. And I want you to learn some things about yourself. The test is for your benefit, so that you will know whether or not you are growing in the Lord. And you will know whether or not you are giving enough time to study. These are very simple statements that require a true/false answer, and I'm allowing you to grade your own paper. Here we go:

Christians need to get closer to God. False. Positionally, you can't get any closer to God than you are because Colossians 3:3 says, "Your life is hid with Christ in God." If your life is hidden with Christ in God, then you are in the company of God; you are in the person of God. You and Jesus and the Holy Ghost and God Almighty Himself are one in faith and one in doctrine, and the devil doesn't have a good shot at you because you're covered up with Christ and covered up with the Holy Ghost and covered up with God the Father. I don't know how you can get any closer to God than what you are right now.

Christians must sin a little bit every day. False. Some people want you to think that you can't take full advantage of grace unless you go out and sin a little. But you don't need to sin every day, and you ought not to sin every day. Romans 6:14 says, "Sin shall not have dominion over you." I don't know how you got saved or where or when. I just know that when you get born again, that old nature is changed. You have a nature that is clean and pure, and you don't need to sin a little bit every day.

Christians *are* **sinners saved by grace**. **False**. Christians used to be sinners. I *was* an old sinner. I used to talk like a sinner and look like a sinner and act like a sinner and dress like a sinner and stink like a sinner. I was a sinner in every possible

way, but I got saved. Romans 5:9 says, "Being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved." We're not justified by our goodness; we're not justified by our self-righteousness; we're not justified by our holy attitude or holy disposition. We are justified by His blood, and we shall be saved because justification came to us at Calvary.

Christians are not dead to sin. False. Romans 6:11 says, "Reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin." How is anybody going to tempt a dead man? The Bible says that if you reach out to Him, He'll come reaching out to you because greater is He that is in you than he that's in the world. And if you'll resist the devil, he will flee from you. The Bible said sin shall not have dominion over you. And the Bible said no weapon formed against you shall prosper. You've got a redemption pedigree. You've got redemption written all over you—"Redeemed At Calvary!" Dead to sin. Righteous indeed. Christians can sin and not know it. False. Sanctification is the changing of your behavior by the Holy Spirit who indwells you. If you're moving in the wrong direction, then the Holy Spirit knows how to bring you back to the road that He's going down, and He will correct your direction. You can depend on God to hold you steady. Once you give your life totally to Christ, you're kind of ruined for sinning, if you know what I'm talking about. It kind of messes up your sinning—call me a taxi. So when you sin, you're going to know about it because the Holy Spirit is going to correct you; He's going to convict you.

It's easier for a Christian to do wrong than to do right. False. The Bible says in Romans 5:20, "Where sin abounded, grace did much more abound." You see it's the nature of an eagle to fly, it's the nature of a fish to swim, it's the nature of a turkey to cluck, it's the nature of a horse to gallop, it's the nature of a rooster to crow, it's the nature of a duck to waddle, it's the nature of a dog to bark, it's the nature of a bee to sting, and it's the nature of a child of God to be a worshipper of God and a follower of Jesus Christ. It's your nature to serve God!


The longer you serve God, the less you will be tempted to sin. False. You don't get a pass on temptation once gray hair covers your head. You will still be tempted because the tempter is always there. But God has taken care of the tempter. The Bible says, "But God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it." It's no sin to be tempted. It's only a sin to yield to temptation. Yes, God is faithful, and He will not allow us to be tempted above that which we're able.

How did you do? Did you do alright? I hope somebody got a hundred percent. I hope somebody got them all. *

WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT?

The Fruit of the Spirit



One of the main functions of the Holy Spirit is to change us, to mold us, to conform us into the image of God's Son, Jesus Christ. In making us Christlike, the evidence of that work is the fruit of the Spirit.

In Gal. 5:19-21, Paul gives to us the acts of a sinful nature that stand in direct opposition to what is good and godly. The use of the term *fruit of the Spirit* plainly tells us that this fruit is the work of God and not the work of man. Only the Holy Spirit can produce this fruit and then only as we yield our lives to His control. We must constantly seek the Holy Spirit to do His work in our lives, for His work is not automatic.

Notice the contrast between the "works of the flesh" in Galatians 5:19-21 and "the fruit of the Spirit" in Galatians 5:22-23.

It becomes obvious that man is incapable of producing anything that can please God. Only the Lord, through the work of the Holy Spirit, can produce that which is fruitful and profitable to His work and our lives.

These nine virtues that are the fruit of the Spirit fall into three categories of three each:

- 1. Godward: love, joy, and peace. These three appear to comprise the Christian's response to God.
- 2. Relational: longsuffering, gentleness, goodness. These three relate to our relationship with others—how we act and treat others around us.
- 3. *Who we are to be in Christ*: faith, meekness, temperance. While all nine speak of godliness, these last three truly portray Christlikeness.

Now let's look at these individually.

LOVE Love in the Greek is *agape* and is the God kind of love (I John 4:16). Agape love, as given in I Corinthians 13, is greater than all the other virtues. No matter what we do for God, if it's not grounded and flowing from agape love, then it will wither and fall. Agape love is a divine quality only produced in the life of a believer. It is a fountain of generosity and forgiveness and kindness. In his book, What the Bible Says About the Holy Spirit, Stanley Horton says of agape love: "This love is the kind of love God shared at Calvary when He sent His Son to die for us while we were yet sinners (Rom. 5:8). Agape love must ever be the fountain which governs everything we do." 1

JOY Joy is the happiness that all believers should radiate; it is an outward expression of the inward peace of redeemed man. This joy is something the world knows nothing about. This

joy is deep, abiding joy that is not ruled by circumstances in one's life. It is the joy of knowing that no matter what happens in our bodies or in relationships, nothing can take this godly joy from us; it is to be our strength (Neh. 8:10). It should be apparent to the believer that joy and affection go hand in hand. One could say that joy is the outward manifestation of inward peace. This separates us from the world. They have no true peace and therefore have no real abiding joy.

PEACE This peace is the peace of God in our hearts, or, one could say that this is sanctifying peace, which is different from justifying peace, which is peace with God. There is a difference between the two. While all who are saved have justifying peace, not all Christians have sanctifying peace. The peace we are speaking of here as one of the virtues or fruit of the Spirit doesn't come easily or quickly. This peace is a work of the Spirit in our lives that comes only as we exhibit faith in the finished work of Christ. As sanctification is progressive, so is the peace that we are describing. This peace comes to be a part of our lives as we make Christ and the cross the object of our faith and the only object of our faith. If one's faith is in anything else, then we frustrate the grace of God, and we will frustrate the development of peace in our lives.

LONGSUFFERING In the Greek, longsuffering is *makrothumia* and speaks of the "steadfastness of the soul under provocation." Kenneth Wuest says of longsuffering: "It includes the idea of forbearance and patient endurance of wrong under ill treatment." Longsuffering is actually patience in the midst of trial knowing that God is faithful, and we are in His hands. One could say it this way, "Suffering long without going to pieces." It is perseverance—never giving up with people or circumstances or life.

GENTLENESS In the Greek, gentleness is *chrestotesz* and refers to kindness. Horton said, "It is sympathetic and gives the soft answer that Solomon says turns away wrath or avoids angry out bursting temper." This kindness is best seen in our forgiveness of others and a kindly disposition to all men.

GOODNESS Goodness in the Greek is *agathosne* and refers to that "quality in a man who is ruled by aims of what is good, namely the quality of moral worth." Goodness and gentleness go together portraying an openhanded generosity that is never begrudging or spiteful. Horton says, "The best way to describe it is being like Jesus."

FAITH Faith in the Greek is *pestio* and refers to "faithfulness and fidelity as produced in the life of the yielded Christian by the Holy Spirit." Faith, as presented throughout the New Testament, focuses on one's complete trust in Christ. However, as a fruit of the Spirit, it more depicts faithfulness, loyalty, trustworthiness, and dependability. As God is faithful, loyal, trustworthy, and dependable, so should His children be.

MEEKNESS In the Greek, meekness is *prautes* and refers to the "qualities of mildness, gentleness, and meekness in dealing with others." This fruit is very difficult to precisely define. Too often one equates meekness with weakness but, in reality, this fruit blends strength and gentleness together. Meekness, as God intends, is really us being gentle and yet not weak.

TEMPERANCE Temperance in the Greek is *egkrateia*, which means "possessing power, strong, having mastery or possession of, and self-control." The word refers to the mystery of one's own desires and impulses. Horton said, "It is the Holy Spirit helping us to develop self-control that masters these desires, impulses, passions and appetites." It also has a specific application to morality and how we live in a jaded society. It is God's purpose that His children live in the world but remain pure from its moral depravity.


Let us all strive to allow the Holy Spirit to do His work in us to produce a life that glorifies Christ through the fruit of the Spirit in our lives.







A Study on Christian Character



Jesus addresses the heart of PART the Christian faith in the Sermon on the Mount, providing significant insights into the character and conduct of believers. Christians can genuinely reflect on the Sermon on the Mount and enjoy the joys and power of the gospel in their lives by adopting these truths.

BLESSED ARE THOSE WHO MOURN

Mourning entails more than merely admitting our spiritual poverty. It entails grieving and sorrow over sin. Christians acknowledge their sense of hopelessness and recognize that no good thing exists within their bodies. Mourning is a natural reaction to being poor in spirit; it is not weeping and mourning over the effects of sin but over sin itself. When we become conscious of our helplessness and hopelessness as we face God's holiness and ponder on the life we are meant to live, we evaluate ourselves and our

lives, identifying the causes of our grief. It involves thoroughly examining our behavior, revealing unforgiveness, and comprehending the underlying causes of our actions, and recognizing that nothing is good inside us and that we require assistance. We lament our shortcomings and inability to meet God's expectations. However, our mourning does not end there. As Christians, we lament the sins of others and the societal breakdown. We. as Christians, should mourn and weep over our cities, our states, our nation. Just as Jesus wept over Jerusalem, we should weep over the state of our society. We do not have to look hard to find things to weep over. Whether it's abortion, murder, drug abuse, or human trafficking, there is plenty to weep over. The list goes on and on, and it should tear our hearts apart. We lament the brokenness and sinfulness that encircles us. Contrary to popular belief, many who mourn find happiness and consolation. The one who

laments his life and sins and repents is the one who seeks answers, and the Holy Spirit works in us to bring our condition up to our position. In other words, the Holy Spirit brings us to the answer: Jesus Christ and Him crucified. We should take solace in the reality that Christ paid for everything that we have as believers through what He accomplished for us at Calvary. The solution we seek can be found in the work of Jesus Christ. We discover that the solution to our spiritual poverty and hope for transformation in our grief is Jesus Christ. Through Him, we find true solace and comfort.

BLESSED ARE THE MEEK

The perspective of the world is drastically different from that of a Christian's. The world favors strength, power, ability, self-assurance, and aggressiveness. However, a Christian stands out as a new creation in Christ and a member of a different kingdom, which is why many

people regard Christians as enigmatic. The world believes that power triumphs over all, but Christ teaches that meekness is what leads to inheriting the planet.

Dr. Martyn Lloyd-Jones has one of the best definitions of the idea of meekness. He states that meekness is essentially an accurate view of oneself, manifested in our attitude and conduct towards others. The one who is meek is the one who is thoroughly amazed that both God and man can think of them and treat them with kindness as they do.¹

Meekness refers to a meek and kind demeanor toward others. The modest Christian does not take pride in himself or delight in himself.

One thing must be understood about meekness and that is not a natural feature, yet it is expected of all Christians. For one to be meek, it cannot be accomplished through our own abilities, but rather accomplished through the Spirit of God as our faith is founded on what Christ has done for us. This attribute cannot be presented entirely unless the cross is understood. Meekness goes hand in hand with enormous strength, authority, and power, and it denotes a teachable attitude. Even if men deprive and disenfranchise us, we will inherit the earth, which means we will reign alongside Christ and be able to enjoy and possess the earth that belongs to Christ.

BLESSED ARE THOSE WHO HUNGER AND THIRST AFTER RIGHTEOUSNESS

The world is looking for happiness but will never find it; instead, they will be filled with sorrow. However, many people in the church seek true happiness but never find it either. They bounce from one church to the next, from one conference to the next, looking for happiness, thinking they will discover something to calm their souls, but they never do. We are not supposed to hunger and thirst for experiences; we are supposed to hunger and thirst for His righteousness. So, what does it mean to be thirsty for righteousness? It denotes a good spiritual appetite.

John Stott said it best when he said there is no greater secret of progress in Christian living than a healthy, hearty spiritual appetite.² We must desire for present and future righteousness, not just mourn our past transgressions. Man has no righteousness that God recognizes, so one must purge oneself of self-righteousness, self-worth, or self-merit and must have a strong yearning for spiritual nourishment, so strong that we shall perish if

we are unsatisfied.

This righteousness concerns justification, which is what righteousness is all about.

However, it is also related to our sanctification. The desire for righteousness, the act of hungering and thirsting for it, ultimately means the desire to be free from sin in all its forms and manifestations. "It means to be sin-free since sin separates us from God...However, it also implies a desire to be free from the influence of sin." It speaks about someone who wishes to be free of the power and oppression of sin, which is only possible because of Christ's finished work.

There is no other way to be free of sin, both on the outer and on the inside. The one who hungers and thirsts for His righteousness longs to be cleansed of the stench of sin.

What are the results of one who hungers and thirsts after His righteousness? It leads to living a holy life before God via faith in Christ and the cross. It denotes a desire to demonstrate the fruit of the Spirit via one's deeds, life, and living. It indicates that one's highest purpose is to know God, connect with Him, and walk alongside God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Above all, whoever hungers and thirsts for righteousness aspires to be like Christ, and they will be satisfied.

THE TRUE CHURCH OF AMERICA IS

Facing Real Persecution



I WAS REARED in an old-fashioned Pentecostal home and often reminded by my dear mother that we live in a sinful world, and if you sincerely live a Christian life, you will be persecuted. She quoted Jesus where He said, "If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you." (John 15:20) She would also cite that verse by the apostle Paul, "Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution" (II Timothy 3:12).

To be honest with you, I did not like these reminders about being required to suffer for Christ. My dad and mom insisted that if a person at school slapped me or hit me, I was to turn the other cheek and not fight back. I hated this so-called "biblical rule." Dad and Mom forbid any of us children to get into a fight while on the school playground or after school. Several times, we were mocked for being poor or for being Pentecostal.

However, God's Word, the teachings of Christ and the apostles clearly tell us that if we determine to live a sincere Christian life, we will experience persecution, and some will even be required to lay down their lives for Christ. And, dear friend, it's coming to America.


Here are some sad statistics concerning persecution and the church:

- More than 360 million Christians suffer worldwide every year high levels of persecution for their faith.
- North Korea is now number one in persecution of Christians. Afghanistan is number nine. China is in the top twenty.

- Over 5,000 churches were destroyed worldwide in 2022.
- Persecution is growing in Latin America—primarily Mexico, Colombia, Cuba, and Nicaragua.
- Worldwide, 5,621 Christians were killed for their faith in 2022. Most killings occurred in Africa. Much bloodshed in Africa.
- Persecution against Christians is growing in parts of India, Iraq, and Latin America.
- Christianity is the most persecuted faith in the world.

Paul experienced much persecution in his life. The apostle Paul wrote these words concerning his suffering: "Of the Jews five times received I forty stripes save one. Thrice was I beaten with rods, once

was I stoned, thrice I suffered shipwreck, a night and a day I have been in the deep; In journeyings often, in perils of waters, in perils of robbers, in perils of mine own countrymen, in perils by the heathen, in perils in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils in the sea, in perils among false brethren; In weariness and painfulness, in watchings often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness. Beside those things that are without, that which cometh upon me daily" (II Cor. 11:24-28).

Brother Paul was willing to be per-

secuted and suffer much to advance the cause of Christ.

Moses understood persecution in the will of God. In Hebrew 11:24-26, we read "By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter; Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season; Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt: for he had respect unto the recompense of the reward."

Moses was willing to experience

persecution to do the will of God. By his willingness to suffer, God used him to change the course of the nation of Israel forever.

As I carefully listen to and review the daily news from television, radio, and the printed page, I am convinced that the spirit of hatred against Christ and the church is spreading across the world and is coming to America. It is already here. In the days and months ahead, I believe Christians will experience more and more persecution and discrimination. I sincerely wish that I did not feel this way, but I do. Dear reader, as a believer, we must get ready for whatever Satan throws at us. Paul urged the Ephesians, "Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil" (Eph. 6:11). In Ephesians 6:18, he exhorts, "Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit."

In Romans 8:35, he asked the question, "Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?" In Romans 8:37 he answers this question: "Nay, in all things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us." Yes, more than conquerors—hallelujah!

What Must I Do When I Fail?

CHRISTIANS WILL FAIL

No matter how long the Christian lives for God, he will never rise above the event of an occasional failing. It is an unrealistic expectation to believe that he will never stumble, falter, or act contrary to God's nature and character. To think so is unscriptural. In Romans 3:23, the Bible declares, "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God." In Ecclesiastes 7:20 Solomon stated, "For there is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not." In I John 1:8, the apostle states, "If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us."

Therefore, we must conclude that every Christian will fail at one time or another. It is not a question as to whether or not we will fail. The question is, what are we to do after failure

occurs? No true believer desires to fail God. The mark of a born-again experience is an inbred love for God and an ongoing hatred of sin. Despite the fact that we hate sin and despite the fact that we do not set out to sin, we will all fall short of the glory of God. What should the believer's response be to personal failure?

CONFESSING OUR SIN TO THE LORD

The Bible teaches that a believer should confess a failure to the Lord. The text of I John 1:9 clearly states this. What this means is that the believer, either verbally or in his heart, acknowledges the fact that he has acted contrary to the nature and character of Christ. A confession is simply an acknowledgment that he is viewing his sinful action in the same way that God does. In essence,

confession is agreeing with God about how He feels about what was done.

In Psalm 32:5 David proclaimed, "I acknowledged my sin unto thee, and mine iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the LORD; and thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin. Selah." Jesus Himself teaches us to pray after this manner, "And forgive us our sins; for we also forgive every one that is indebted to us" (Luke 11:4). And finally, after the new covenant has been established, the author of our text declares that Christians should confess their sins to the Lord. These passages reveal a consistent expected response to failure throughout the whole body of Scripture. There is teaching today that tells the believer that I John was written to the lost. This is a faulty argument. There is absolutely no evidence that I John was written to those who were not saved.

The sinner does not confess specific sins when he comes to Christ; there are far too many. The sinner confesses to the Lord that he is a sinner and that the accumulation of sin over his lifetime has permanently separated him from God. Therefore, the instruction given in I John is meant specifically for believers and is the appropriate action to take after a failure.

SINS PAST, PRESENT, AND FUTURE

Christian doctrine states that Jesus has paid the penalty for all sins—past, present, and future. This is truth. The penalty that Jesus paid was sufficient to cover and atone for every single sin of every single human being that has ever lived or ever will live. Jesus has already paid the price for all sin. That truth in no way states that we should not pay attention to the failings in our present life. To successfully move beyond the failure of the present, we must experience the assurance that failure has been placed permanently behind us. When we confess our sins, we do so with the confidence that Christ has already paid sin's debt. Confessing our sin must include an active and present faith in Christ's payment of our sin. By confessing sin to God, the believer is then freed from a continual sense of shame and guilt. Confession is not made because we doubt Christ's payment for sin on Calvary. Confession is made because we are expressing faith in Christ's payment for sin on Calvary.

JUSTIFICATION AND FAILURE

Justification is a wonderful status that God has granted to all believers. It states that our position of righteousness has been

freely granted by God as the result of faith in Christ. If our faith is continually resting upon Christ and His finished work, then the blessings of justification are not eliminated, even when we fail. With a proper understanding of justification, I do not neglect confession of my sin before God. Instead, I take the opportunity to clear away the damage done to my relationship with God by sin.

Unlike some, I do believe that a person can lose justification after truly being saved. But not through the action of a single sin. Rather, if sin is held to or not dealt with properly, then the believer's faith comes under direct attack. When there is a lack of confidence in the provision of God, the believer begins to stumble, unsure of himself and his relationship with the Lord. If this is not attended to properly, one's faith could fail and that would result in the horrifying loss of the status of justification.

Prior to Peter's failure, Jesus told him, "I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not." Jesus knew that Peter would fail but was most concerned about what happened after—that Peter's faith would stand the test of his own failure. If our faith fails because of embracing sin or a failure to put sin behind us, then the danger of destroying the foundation of justification exists. If our faith is destroyed, then the status of justification can also be lost.

IN CONCLUSION

What is the answer? When you sin, take that failure to the Lord. Ask Him to forgive you, knowing full well that the penalty for sin has already been paid for. Then, you can be sure that God, who is faithful and just, has forgiven you of your sin and cleansed you from all unrighteousness. This knowledge will allow you to march forward in your relationship with Christ without fear, shame, or guilt. Amen and amen!

EDUCATION DILEMMA How is it that major universities throughout the U.S. are not protesting the Hamas war against Israel but instead protest the very existence of Jews? The genocidal phrase, "From the river to the sea," is well understood to mean no Jewish State and no Jews in the land.

The Big Dilemma

THROUGHOUT HISTORY, antisemitism flourished on every continent of the world. But how can it be possible that right here, in the United States of America, Jews can feel threatened and fearful as our citadels of learning promote diversity, equality, and inclusion (DEI)?

Could foreign funding to our universities be a persuasive part of the dichotomy that exists to make it acceptable to hate Jews and support terrorist organizations such as Hamas?

The Heritage Foundation states that "instead of promoting diverse perspectives, too many programs reflect the leftward biases of their universities—some even going so far as to promote antisemitism. These programs are funded under Title VI of the Higher Education Act and are known as the International and Foreign Language Education programs. Congress created these programs to support the 'security, stability, and economic vitality of the United States in a complex global era."

Education's reputation is at a low point, particularly with university leaders, faculty leaders, and students as they demonstrate moral confusion at best and advocacy for terrorism at worst over the Hamas-Israel war.

ORIGINS OF HATE-FILLED IDEOLOGY

Islamic terrorist organizations all share the same ideological foundation. Al Qaeda, Hamas, ISIS, Taliban, etc. all subscribe to Muslim Brotherhood (MB) principles.

The MB was founded in 1928. It had a twofold purpose: (1) to implement Shariah worldwide, and (2) to reestablish the imperial Islamic state. This is also known by Muslims as the caliphate. How to accomplish this task varies from organization to organization, but their goal is the same.

The MB's creed is, "Allah is our objective; and death for the sake of Allah is the highest of our aspirations." Although death through martyrdom is a means to accomplish its goals, MB ideology believes that, currently, it's best to advance itself through non-violent means—cultural revolution or stealth jihad. It uses stealthy techniques by establishing relationships with influence wherever possible—infiltration into government positions in executive and legislative branches at the federal and state levels, law enforcement, intelligence agencies, the military, penal institutions, and the educational system. In the West, this ideology has gained much sympathy in our learning institutions, especially colleges and universities.

DESTINATION: THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

In 1946, the death of the Muslim Brotherhood's founder Hasan Al Banna did not leave a void in its succession and leadership. Saeed Ramadan, married to Banna's daughter, continued the MB goal of creating an Islamic world ruled by Sharia law. With America focused on communism, advisors of President Eisenhower's defense and intelligence team saw an opportunity for the U.S. to influence the Muslim world and use them against

communism. In 1953, prominent members of the MB were invited to Princeton University for an "Islamic colloquium" and were also invited to meet President Eisenhower, including Saeed Ramadan. This opened the door to welcome a new community of Muslims to America.

INDOCTRINATION THROUGH EDUCATION

In 1963, the MB established its first front organization in the U.S., The Muslim Students Association (MSA). MSA chapters are present at most college and university campuses today, serving as recruiting facilities for MB and, in some cases, for violent jihadist organizations. Nearly all Muslim organizations in North America today came out of the MSA.

As chapters of the MSA grew on campuses across America, they presented Islam in public as an acceptable alternative to other religions, never mentioning its revolutionary aspects.

In 1973, Saudi Arabia formed a significant enabler for MB operations in the U.S. and domination of Muslim communities. They formed the North American Islamic Trust (NAIT). NAIT controls approximately 80 percent of the titles/deeds to the mosques, Islamic organizations, and Islamic schools in America. Accompanying this ownership is their installation of leadership—Saudi-trained and appointed imams (leaders and/or teachers of Islamic faith and duty), textbooks for the Muslim schools (madrassas), jihadist literature and videos for the bookstores and other material to influence the Muslim community in the United States.

STRATEGY REVEALED

From its origin, the MB sought to reestablish a global caliphate. This was confirmed through documents discovered when an FBI field office raided Ismael Elbarasse's home in Annandale,

Virginia. In his basement they found documents that confirmed what investigators suspected and contended about the many Muslim-American groups in the United States, namely that nearly all of them are controlled by the MB and therefore Shariah law and its dictates, which are hostile to America.

The Holy Land Foundation Trial in 2007 revealed evidence that the largest Muslim charity in the U.S. had funneled money and assistance to Hamas overseas in support of terrorist operations. Hamas has been designated a Foreign Terrorist Organization (FTO) by the U.S. government since 1996, and it is a Palestinian wing of the MB.

AN EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The MB's strategic plan for North America was discovered in the FBI raid on Elbarasse's house. The document was approved by the Shura Council in 1987 and established its mission in the United States: "The process of settlement is a 'Civilization-Jihadist Process' with all the word means. The Ikhwan [MB] must understand that their work in America is a kind of grand Jihad in eliminating and destroying the Western civilization from within and 'sabotaging' its miserable house by their hands and the hands of the believers so that it is eliminated and God's [Allah's] religion is made victorious over all other religions."²



"In the beginning God created..." -GENESIS 1:1





GOD DOES NOT explain this introductory statement. He simply states it as a fact. If you believe the first verse of the Bible, then you will have no problems with the miracles found in the remainder of the Holy Scriptures. If you struggle with the first verse of the Bible, then you will struggle with the rest of the Bible. Although there are many who would argue the existence of God, it takes more faith to believe in evolution than to believe in divine creation. That being said, it is reasonable to expect that this

Creator desires to be known. It is equally reasonable to believe that He would supply a tangible revelation of Himself. He did. Through the study of His Word we are given a revelation of God.

GOD REVEALS HIMSELF TO MAN

For us to know God, He must reveal Himself to us in such a way that we could understand. For a nuclear physicist to explain the intricate study of atomic nuclei and their constituents, he must explain in such a way that we could

comprehend it. If not, it would be a complete waste of time. God, who is so much greater than man, must reveal who He is in such a way that we could understand that revelation.

DIVINE INSPIRATION

The apostle Paul tells us that God's Word was given to man through divine inspiration. "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness" (II Tim. 3:16). The Holy Spirit used the faculties and vocabularies of the authors of the sixty-six books of the Bible during the act of inspiration. The Bible is therefore the Word of God recorded through the agency of divinely inspired authors.

GOD SPOKE

In the Bible, God says over twenty-five hundred times, "God said," "the Lord hath said," "thus saith the Lord," and

so on. The book of Hebrews begins with, "God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets" (Heb. 1:1). Peter echoes this truth: "Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost" (II Peter 1:20-21). God speaks to us today through His Word.

GOD REVEALS THE SAVIOR

Every book in the Bible speaks of Jesus Christ prophetically, historically, or through types and shadows. This is called the Christocentric theme of the Bible. Genesis 3:15 is the first promise of the coming gospel (the Protoevangelium): "And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel." Brother Swaggart says, "Jesus, the seed of the woman would bruise the head of the serpent on the cross. The serpent would bruise the heel of the Savior, which speaks of the suffering of the cross."1 Even before Adam and Eve were expelled from God's garden, God gave them a promise of redemption.

KNOW HIM

God reveals who He is so that we can have a relationship with Him. That relationship has its genesis at the cross. Through Calvary, religion is replaced by relationship. Through Jesus Christ, we can know God. In next month's article, we will go into more detail on how sinful man can know a holy God. *

"O magnify the Lord with me, and let us exalt his name together." -PSALM 34:3

Magnify The Lord With Me

WHAT DOES IT mean to magnify? People use a pair of binoculars to make things look bigger. However, when binoculars are turned around, they make things look smaller. Each person decides, by faith, how they are going to look at and believe about God, themselves, and circumstances. Lucifer and Cain are examples of individuals who tried to magnify themselves so that they looked bigger than God.

God described Lucifer, or Satan, as perfect in beauty (Ezek. 28:12), but

because of his beauty he chose to be proud, or lifted up. Therefore, he became corrupted (Ezek. 28:17) and defiled (Ezek. 28:18). Isaiah described him as saying, "I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High" (Isa. 14:14).

Instead of the required blood sacrifice, Cain brought a sacrifice of plants that he had grown and refused to bring an acceptable offering even when his offering was rejected and the right kind was available to him (Gen. 4:4-7). Not only did he rebel from going God's way, but he also killed his brother, Abel, who had obeyed God, so he thought he would not look so bad to God and others (Gen. 4:8).

People choose how they see or what they believe about their circumstances. Several times the Israelites saw their circumstances as bigger than God. When Pharaoh's army was chasing them, and they came to the Red Sea, they said they would have been better off as slaves in Egypt (Ex. 14:12). One time, when they had no water, they asked Moses why he had led them out of Egypt so that he could kill them with thirst in the wilderness (Ex. 17:3). When they had no food, they said it would have been better for them to have died in Egypt (Ex. 16:3). When they finally came to the promised land that was full of walled cities and giants, they said they should elect a new leader to take them back to Egypt (Num. 14:4). In essence, they were saying that their circumstances were bigger than God.

The same is true of an individual who turns from the grace of God and grows a root of bitterness (Heb. 12:15). Instead of

trusting God and forgiving a person who has hurt them, people not only choose not to forgive and to be bitter, but they also feed their bitterness until it grows bigger (Acts 8:18-23; Eph. 4:31). They are doing the opposite of what a sign I saw said: "Don't tell God how big your problem is but tell your problem how big your God is."

People use their faith like binoculars to either make God bigger or smaller. But people can never make Him bigger than He is, and that is why God continually tells them to magnify Him, so that He will always be bigger than themselves and their circumstances. The mistake is that most of the time they believe He is smaller than He really is.

Each person needs to ask himself, "How big is your God?"

How a person chooses to look at things, or what he believes about them makes a big difference. He can look at problems as impossibilities or as opportunities. God says, "The things which are impossible with men are possible with God" (Luke 18:27). As Oscar Eliason's song says:

Got any rivers you think are uncrossable? Got any mountains you can't tunnel through? God specializes in things thought impossible, and He can do what no other power can do.

Each person chooses what he is going to magnify and ultimately put his faith in—either God, himself, or circumstances.

The areas in the world that we go to, where church is a premium—and church is our telecast, our television programming—that's the only church they'll ever




have. And it's very, very important to them. We have to pay for the airtime as you well understand, so I need your help on a constant basis with this.




